This document provides the steps to install the Clearspan 6800 and 6900 series phones that have been provisioned for the Clearspan System.

Before Installation, you must configure the Phone Type in Clearspan, and the User and Device, in OpEasy.

1	Create a User and Assign the Mitel Phone to the User.	
2	Start with a Factory Defaulted Phone.	
<b>Determine the IP Address of the Mitel 6863i and 6865i Phones</b>		
3	Press the <b>Option</b> Key. 	The <b>Options</b> List is displayed.
4	Using the <b>Navigation/Select</b> Keys.  Scroll down to <b>Phone Status</b> option. Select the option.	The <b>Phone Status</b> page is displayed.
5	Scroll down to the IP and MAC Address option. Select the option	The IP Address is displayed.
<b>Determine IP Address of the Mitel 6867i, 6869i, 6920 and 6930 Phones</b>		
6	Press the <b>Option</b> Key. 	The <b>Settings</b> screen is displayed. The Status is highlighted.
7	Press <b>Select</b> .	The <b>Status</b> page is displayed.
8	Using the <b>Navigation/Select</b> Keys  Scroll down to <b>Network</b> .	The IP Address is displayed.

<b>Determine IP Address of the Mitel 6873i and 6940 Phones</b>		
9	<p>Press the <b>Option</b> Key</p> 	The <b>Settings</b> screen is displayed.
10	Touch <b>Status</b> .	The <b>Status</b> page is displayed.
11	Touch <b>Network</b> .	The IP Address is displayed.
<b>Phone Configuration if DHCP Server Address is not available. If the DHCP Server Address is Available go to Auto Install</b>		
12	<p>Log on to the Phone's web portal</p> <p>For example: http://&lt;Phone's IP&gt;</p>	A Sign in box is displayed
13	<p>Enter the Username: admin</p> <p>Enter the Password: 22222</p> <p>Click <b>OK</b> or Sign in</p>	The <b>Mitel System Information</b> page is displayed.
14	Select <b>Configuration Server</b> on the navigation tree.	The <b>Configuration Server Setting</b> page is displayed. The Download Protocol displayed is TFTP.
15	Select <b>HTTPS</b> from the Download Protocol drop-down list	The HTTPS options are enabled.
16	<p>Enter the HTTPS server.</p> <p>For example: tb20xsp.cslab.mitel.com</p> <p>Enter the HTTPS Path.</p> <p>For example: dms/clearspan</p> <p>Enter the HTTPS Port, if needed.</p> <p>For example: 443</p> <p>Click <b>Save Settings</b>.</p>	The Provisioning Complete message is displayed.
17	Select <b>Reset</b> from the Navigation tree.	The <b>Reset</b> page is displayed.
18	Press the <b>Restart</b> button.	A confirmation box is displayed.
19	Click <b>OK</b> .	The Phone will restart.

20	<p>Enter the Phone's Auto Install ID.</p> <p>Press <b>Done</b> or use the <b>Navigation/Select</b> Keys to select Enter.</p>	The <b>Confirm User</b> screen is displayed.
21	If the User is correct, Press <b>OK</b> , or use the Navigation/Select keys to select Done.	<p>The Phone Restarts a few times.</p> <p>The correct configuration is displayed on the phone</p>

1	Press the <b>Option</b> Key. 	The <b>Options</b> List is displayed.
2	Using the <b>Navigation/Select</b> Keys,  scroll down to Restart Phone. Select <b>Enter</b> .	The following message is displayed:  Restart Phone? Cancel  # Confirm
3	Press # key to restart the phone	The phone will restart.
<b>Restart Mitel 6867i, 6869i, 6920 and 6930</b>		
4	Press the <b>Option</b> Key. 	The <b>Settings</b> screen is displayed.  The status is hi-lighted.
5	Scroll to Restart.  Press <b>Select</b> .	A Restart Phone box is displayed with the following message:  Restart Phone? Yes No
6	Select <b>Yes</b> .	The Phone will restart.
<b>Restart Mitel 6873i and 6940</b>		
7	Press the <b>Option</b> Key. 	The <b>Settings</b> screen is displayed.
8	Swipe the second page, if required.	A <b>Restart Phone</b> box is displayed with the following message:
